
Every term, parents pay subs for their child to attend Beavers, Cubs or Scouts. However WE don't get to keep ALL the money given...

In 2016 on average we received £90 subs from each child belonging to 2<sup>nd</sup> Southwick. The chart to the right shows where this money goes.

The Amount left for 2<sup>nd</sup> Southwick has to cover the bills (electricity, water, buildings insurance), plus any expenses for the Sections programme of activities.

Therefore FUNDRAISING of any kind is paramount to the survival of the GROUP!



So where does it go...

**National - £25 -** Programme Support, Support for the recruitment, Development grants, Safeguarding advice, Insurance for all members (public liability: personal accident and trustees indemnity), Membership and customer services, Legal services, Information Centre, Regional Development Service.

**County - £14 -** Training/Administration

**District - £5 -** Support/District events

Hillside - £6 - Enables the group to attend activities at Hillside without additional cost (normally £3 for head per night)

**2nd Southwick - £40** – Hut Maintenance/Heating/Water/Lighting/Buildings insurance/Members additional insurance. As well as expense incurred running the Section programme activities
