

### Scouts Challenging 4 Mile Walk 2021

Please wear suitable footwear as the walk can be muddy and slippery when wet, also wear long trousers as there are brambles to contend with in places.



We go to the top of Upper Kingston Lane and up the Restricted Byway.



We pass a large sarsen stone on the left 'Rest and Be Thankful'. Can you see the Devil's footprint?



As our path veers right then left, we turn right through a field gate, then turn left, uphill, on a wide grassy track.



With a guide post on our right we bear left on a wide, rising, grassy path.



Passing through a 'squeeze' next to a field gate, we follow the wide main track up until we reach a path fork, we bear left.



Crossing a nearby stile on our left, we turn right soon passing through a gate between two field gates and up a bridleway track.



We turn right immediately **before** a field gate next to a broken bridleway gate, onto a narrow, winding, downhill path, keeping the left fence in view.



Near the bottom left corner, we go through a metal gate, onto a challenging narrow path down through brambles and scrub.



Emerging we keep to the meandering path along the hillside, eventually descending towards the bottom left corner.



Near the bottom left corner, we clamber over a stile with dog gate, soon turning right onto a wide farm track.



At a pylon by a fingerpost, we turn right on a wide path then bears left, soon passing through a gate and turning left up a sunken track.



At a three way fingerpost we leave the track, bearing left onto a wide, gently rising grassy path.



After another fingerpost on our right, we bear right in 25 metres, uphill to a broken gate at the top.



We go through the gate on a footpath descending across a field.

On reaching houses we go through the kissing gate turn right down the road, back to Upper Kingston Lane, returning to the Scout hut.
